

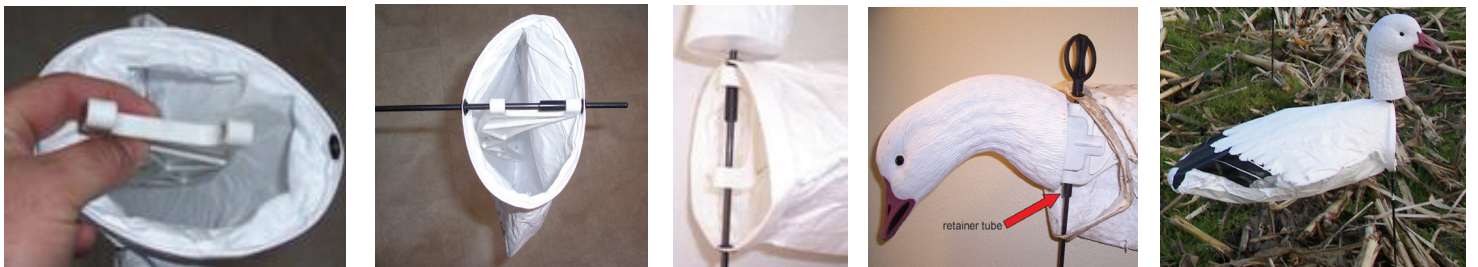


Assembly Instructions

1. There are three styles of decoys. Headed have a thread on head. Headless and Feeder head decoys use our thread on loop at the top of the stake.
2. Take the decoy head/loop and the stake. The top of the stake is the end that is threaded. Applying lock tight to the threads will keep the head/loop from unthreading while hunting. On looped stakes the threaded insert is in at the bottom of the loop. The upright heads (sentry and searcher style) have a threaded insert molded at the top of the head. Stick the stake into the hole in the bottom of the head. Gentle tapping maybe required to get the thread through the bottom hole of the decoy and up to the threaded insert in the top.



3. Next take the rubber retainer tubing that will hold the decoy on the stake and place them in warm water for easier assembly. We will use them in later steps.
4. Insert the BackBone™ Support into the body of the decoy. Make sure the end that has the holes is in the opening of the bag and the arch is towards the top side of the body bag. Feeder heads only – The U shaped portion on the back of the head and the U shaped between the fingers of the support fit together. The stake holes will line up.
5. Non-feeder head decoys: Take the bottom end of the stake and insert it into the top grommet hole of the Body Bag and BackBone™ Support. Place the tubing on the stake. Slide the stake through the bottom hole of the support and grommet of the body. Grab the support and body. Slide the support, body, and tubing up the stake until it touches the bottom of the head/loop. You will still have to slide the tubing up a little farther with your fingers. Ideal location is when a small gap remains between the head and body bag.
6. Feeder Heads: Take the bottom end of the stake and insert it into the top of the grommet through the top hole of the support, through the feeder head, and out the bottom hole of the support. Slide on the retainer tube. Tubing location will be under the support because of the feeder head. Then stick the stake through the bottom hole of the body grommet. Slide everything towards the loop. Ideal location is when a small gap remains between the head and the Body Bag.
